The Book of Ephesians is Paul's clearest call to a spiritually distracted, divided, identity-confused church to **wake up** to what is already true about them in Christ.

In a world filled with noise, pressure, comparison, loneliness, and confusion, students are asking the same questions the Ephesians asked:

- Who am I really?
- Where do I belong?
- How do I navigate sexuality, unity, purpose, and relationships?
- How do I live awake, not numb?

Ephesians declares: **You don't achieve your identity by trying harder, you wake up and receive who God has already made you to be in Christ.**

5. Wake Up to Your Purpose. Eph. 4:1–16	Maturity is not performance, it's participation.	Deconstruction, church hurt
6. Wake Up to Real Love. Eph. 5:1–14	God's love frees you from counterfeit intimacy.	Lust, hookup culture
7. Wake Up to Spirit-Filled Relationships. Eph. 5:21–6:9	To be Spirit-filled is to be servant-hearted.	Dating, family wounds
8. Wake Up to the Real Battle. Eph. 6:10–20	You fight FROM victory, not FOR victory.	Anxiety, spiritual warfare
